United Voice together with the Social Welfare Department (JKMM) organized 4 Self-advocacy Conferences for coordinators and supervisors from Pusat Pemulihan Komuniti Centers (PDKs) from all states in Peninsula Malaysia in 2011. A total of 439 participants attended the conferences. The objective of the conferences is to create awareness among the PDKs coordinators on the importance of self-advocacy, how to impart self-advocacy skills to their students and the importance of forming self-advocacy groups. We have also invited other self-advocacy groups, Adventure Club(Selangor), Friendship Club(Kuala Lumpur), Kumpulan Sri Chepa(Kelantan) and Mutiara Voice Club(Penang) to share about their experience and activities at the conferences. Next year, 2012 United Voice will be organizing 2 more self-advocacy conferences at East Malaysia targeting another 100 participants. Through these conferences 17 new self-advocacy groups have been formed in 4 states in Kelantan, Johor, Selangor & Kedah.

## 5. UV Employment Project

26 UV members are employed in United Voice Employment Project. They receive a monthly salary and annual bonus based on productivity with SOCSO and EPF. They also receive the EPC of RM300 from the Welfare Department.

The Employment Project main business is the card and craft studio which produces festival greeting cards, magnets, bookmarks, and hand-woven products such as keychains, scarfs and others. We also print business cards for companies which has mainly 1 main corporate company which generates revenue towards sustaining the project. The saori products have increase in sales as we supplied customized saori magnets to a company this year.

The festival card business in 2011 has maintained its customer base with an addition of a few corporations who purchase our cards in bulk as part of their corporate social responsibility. While we have maintained most of our customers, some customers have moved into sending e-cards thus have stopped buying the handmade greeting cards from UV.

The gift shop has visitors from students from colleges, PDK groups and corporations who visit UV. Walk-in customers are not as frequent for the gift shop.

Two other core business of the project is the bakery and art gallery.

The bakery has potential for further expansion of business selling bread, tarts and cookies. We have established the stall at Sec17 Pasar Tani to sell our bakery products every week on Thursdays. The sale from the stall is average and there is a need to have greater promotion of our bread and cookies to establish a wider customer base for the bakery. Maintaining food safety and cleanliness is important to produce high quality products which we need to constantly monitor. We have supplied about 35 hampers to a company this year with our cookies as the main items in the hamper. This has boosted the sales of cookies.

The art gallery has showcased its first external exhibition in collaboration with the Ministry of Tourism. The exhibition was held for 1 month in conjunction with the 1Malaysia Contemporary Art Tourism Festival 2011 at MATIC (Pusat Pelancongan Malaysia). UV sold about RM20,000 worth of art pieces during the exhibition. Apart from the exhibition, visitors to UV gallery also purchase art.
